Exploring regional demand





MENA's rich culture and traditions drive genre content



Tv content taste preferences have evolved over the last 5 years...

- Drama's dominance: Drama remains the top audience choice reflecting the region's rich storytelling traditions which include high-concept narratives, historical epics, and more.
- Consistent appeal of comedy: Comedy remains an evergreen genre exhibiting a consistent demand share over time.
- Anime's ascent: The surge in animation demand, from 6% in 2018 to 11% in 2023, can be attributed to the rising popularity of Anime, resonating with both younger and adult audiences in MENA.
- Children's content growth: Demand for children's content has more than doubled over the last five years, indicating a focus on younger viewers.
- Action & adventure's dip: At a higher price point, networks & streamers have turned their attention to cheaper alternatives, especially within the unscripted space.



Growing demand for non-English content





Global demand for non-English content is rising...

Globally, the demand for non-English content has nearly doubled *since 2018*, now at an all-time high. This is due to greater access supported by worldwide platforms and international production requirements.

Even demand for non-English content in the US has leaped more than +50% over the past three years thanks to improved dubbing, subtitling, and cultural adoption.

Technology is making the world smaller but a viewer's entertainment ecosystem larger, influencing viewer preferences.





Even more evident in the MENA Region...



Within the MENA Region, the demand for Non-English content accounts for over half of the total demand, showcasing a remarkable shift in viewer preferences.

Specifically, Arabic content now represents over a quarter of the total demand in MENA, almost doubling the demand seen in 2022.

This presents a great opportunity for local stories to shine through culturally relevant narratives.

Hollywood is no longer the holy-grail of entertainment



Across the region, opportunities for regional productions are increasing

Audience demand levels for local language, Arabic, and non-English content are growing as platforms and distributors increasingly program for international reach versus merely distributing big English language blockbusters.

Culturally specific content is a prime way to build market share in targeted regions.





Asian-Language TV is bridging the Global Demand-Supply Gap



The surge in demand for major Asian language titles is rapidly approaching the current supply, signaling a growing desire for such content.

Historically, South Korean series only run for one season, but rapturous demand for breakout hits such as *Squid Game, Big Bet* and *The Glory* are changing established norms.

The overall increase is partly driven by Japanese animation, which was the most sought-after subgenre globally throughout 2022 and 2023.



Japanese TV content dominates, leading global demand

Good stories come from everywhere.

Japanese language series boasted the highest global audience demand share of the major Asian languages last quarter at 10% thanks to anime and live-action hits such as *Alice in Borderland*.

Japanese animation has enjoyed a meteoric rise since Q1 2020 and now ranks in the top three in demand over supply globally.





White Space Analysis & Content Travelability





Balancing local specifics with global themes captivates diverse audiences

Applying the economic principle of supply and demand allows us to identify the themes in content that have the most potential for success.

Both Japanese Anime and Crime Drama are two of the strongest performing subgenres, outlining their potential when testing concepts for new productions.

These subgenres harness universal motifs and themes that resonate with audiences across the globe, reflecting the power of relatable narratives, while also utilizing genre storytelling elements to provide engrossing entertainment.





Crime Drama & Japanese Animation both travel well and transcend boundaries

Genre Travelability

Bubble size denotes regional genre demand

Genres like romantic and family drama, cooking reality & lifestyle reality, are tailored to local audiences with cultural references, humour, and themes specific to the region, making them less likely to resonate internationally. These shows often rely on language, social norms, and regional themes and as a result, their international appeal is limited

Genres that show high travelability often rely on universal themes, relatable characters, and captivating storytelling that transcend cultural boundaries, making them popular among diverse audiences. Additionally, these genres often feature elements that resonate with a global viewership, such as thrilling action, compelling narratives, and visually stunning animation.





Universal motifs and gripping tales will get them watching...

Successful non-English content integrates universal motifs, resonating with shared human experiences through unique creative visions. Compelling storytelling explores themes like love, family, and resilience - bridging cultural barriers. Whether intense family dramas or action-packed adventures, captivating narratives strike a balance between a gripping premise and authentic emotion.

Brazilian crime drama *Criminal Code*, the half-English/Japanese crime drama *Tokyo Vice*, and Colombia's romance thriller *Fake Profile* are all successful examples.

Why? Because they deliver universality through specificity, helping audiences feel seen regardless of nationality.

Looking at the content performance of titles from 'non-traditional' markets, we see many that have travelled beyond borders.

Markets like Colombia & Poland stand out as potentials thanks to high travelability of native content, strong audience demand levels domestically and internationally, and concepts/themes that closely mirror the most globally popular English language programming.



Japanese Cinema and Television Captivates Audiences Worldwide

Japanese entertainment, spanning from the high-energy anime series to the evocative realms of its cinema, has captured the imagination of audiences globally. Animated series like *Saint Seiya* offer a blend of mythology and action that resonates across cultures, while *Jujitsu Kaisen* embodies the supernatural with its intense story arcs, carving out a loyal fanbase. *Spy X Family* juxtaposes the spy genre with familial bonds, creating a unique narrative that appeals to viewers of all ages.





On the cinematic front, films like *Godzilla Minus One* reimagines the iconic monster saga with a contemporary twist, and *The Boy and The Heron* explores the delicate interplay between humans and nature. The critically acclaimed *Shoplifters* delves into the nuanced layers of family and society, illustrating the complex moral landscapes that Japanese filmmakers navigate with deftness.

The rising demand for Japanese content is a testament to its unique ability to marry the particular with the universal, the new with the traditional, and the individual with the collective. This growing trend is not ephemeral but a solid movement towards a more inclusive global entertainment landscape where stories from Japan are not just welcomed but eagerly anticipated.

Colombia's filmmakers capture the beauty and complexity of their land, from its lush landscapes to its urban vibrancy, such as in the film *Running with the Devil.* Storytellers are not afraid to tackle hard-hitting topics that resonate on a human level and inspire change, making their films more accessible and impactful.

The global influence of Colombian talent extends beyond the screen with artists like *Karol G* and *J Balvin* revolutionizing the music scene, while stars like *Shakira* and *Sofia Vergara* have become household names worldwide.
